The Commission on Human Rights strongly condemns the killing of Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) Officer Enrico Barba in violation of his right to life.

On February 18, 2019, the body of Officer Barba was found lifeless in a dead creek in Barangay Napolidan, Lupi, Camarines Sur. Officer Barba was an officer of PDEA, and was also the Assistant Provincial Officer of PDEA Camarines Norte. He was performing his duty on the day that he was killed.

Specifically, CHR 5 denounces the violation of the inherent right of all person to life. This right is fully guaranteed by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) as well as by the 1987 Philippine Constitution. The taking away of one's life without due process of law clearly violates the person's right which he should enjoy regardless of his sex, age, gender, political affiliation, status and the like.

We affirm our commitment to work hand in hand with other agencies in ensuring respect to human rights and full accountability of the perpetrators to obtain justice for the victim and his family. We likewise call on other sectors to help us and our law enforcement agencies in the conduct of our investigation in the spirit of justice.

True to our mandate, our Naga Sub-Office has already started to conduct its investigation right after news of Officer Barba's death broke out.
