## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-98

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SOUTHEAST ASIA ORGANIZATION IN THEIR ADVOCACY AND PROGRAM ON CLIMATE CHANGE.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Capalonga, Camarines Norte is strongly committed to improve its environment for a balanced, stable, and healthful ecology not only to maintain its status, but also in its genuine desire to preserve the environment for its present and future constituents and those who wish to visit the municipality for whatever purpose;

WHEREAS, to implement the aforementioned avowed commitment, the municipality of Capalonga, Camarines Norte adopted "Green governance" as a major flagship program to sustain its aggressive programs on clean air and water and proper waste management, among others;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan learned of the landmark Climate Change and Human Rights Petition filed by Greenpeace Southeast Asia and Philippine Rural Reconstruction Movement, together with twelve (12) non-profit organizations and eighteen (18) individuals (collectively referred hereinafter as "Petitioners") before the Commission on Human Rights requesting for investigation on the responsibility of forty seven (47) multinational fossil fuel and cement companies ("Carbon Majors") for human right violations or threat of violations resulting from the impacts of climate change.

WHEREAS, the Commission on Human Rights is currently conducting a national inquiry regarding the aforesaid Climate Change and Human Rights Petition;

WHEREAS, to further its green initiatives as articulated above, the municipality of Capalonga, Camarines Norte joints the Petitioners in their quest for climate justice and supports the Commission on Human Rights in this historic national inquiry that has potential to deliver the world's first finding on corporate responsibility for human rights harms resulting from climate change and empower Filipino communities to reclaim their right to safe climate and a balanced, stable and healthful ecology.
