A woman named Catherine Bulatao had complications giving birth in their house in Caloocan City and eventually died after she was denied by several hospitals.

The midwife who assisted her in giving birth said that she must be immediately brought to a hospital to remove her placenta from her uterus. She was brought to North Caloocan Doctors Hospital, Far Eastern University Hospital in Quezon City, Bermudez Hospital, Skyline Hospital and Grace Hospital in Bulacan but Catherine was declared dead on arrival when she was brought to San Jose del Monte General Hospital.

The family of Catherine will file the appropriate suit against the hospitals which turned them down. Relative thereto, the Department of Justice ordered the National Bureau of Investigation to conduct an investigation as regards the incident.
